CHAPTER 587.

AN ACT to appropriate \$468 to Harvey A. Nelson of Union Grove, Wisconsin to compensate him for damage done to his property by 3 escapees from the southern colony and training school on the evening of May 12, 1949.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

There is appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$468 to Harvey A. Nelson of Union Grove, Wisconsin to compensate him for damage done to his property being a tractor and a 4-row corn planter by 3 escapees from the southern colony and training school, Union Grove, Wisconsin on the evening of May 12, 1949. Acceptance of this appropriation shall operate as a full and complete release to the state of any claim on the part of Harvey A. Nelson on account of such damage.
