CHAPTER 639.

AN ACT to amend 313.03 (1) of the statutes, relating to the time for filing claims against estates.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

313.03 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

313.03 (1) Upon filing an application for administration of the estate or probating the will of a decedent, or at any time thereafter the court shall by order fix the time (not less than 3 months nor more than one year from the date of the order) within which claims against the decedent may be presented; and designate the term at which claims shall be examined and adjusted. The time limited for filing claims may be extended (but not beyond 2 years from the date of the letters) upon the application of a claimant filed * * * *prior to the approval of the final account in said estate*, and upon a showing satisfactory to the court and upon such notice as the court shall direct. Such extension may be general or may be limited to the applicant.
