CHAPTER 82.

AN ACT to create 14.715 of the statutes, relating to transportation of certain employes of the conservation commission and the public welfare department to and from work.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

14.715 of the statutes is created to read:

14.715 TRANSPORTATION OF EMPLOYES. The state department of public welfare and the conservation commission may, with the approval of the governor and the director of personnel, provide group transportation, in the absence of convenient and public scheduled transportation, for employes to and from Mendota and Winnebago state hospitals, the northern and southern colonies and training schools, the Wisconsin school for girls, the Wisconsin home for women in the case of employes of the state department of public welfare, and to and from its temporary branch offices located at the Nevin fish hatchery grounds in the case of employes of the conservation commission. Any employe, if injured while being so transported, shall be deemed to have been in the course of his employment.
