**CHAPTER 86.**

AN ACT to amend 311.06 (introductory paragraph) of the statutes, relating to appointment of special administrator.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

311.06 (introductory paragraph) of the statutes is amended to read:

311.06 (introductory paragraph) Whenever it shall appear by petition to the county court of any county that a resident of the county has died or that a person not a resident of this state has died leaving estate to be administered in such county a special administrator may be appointed where one or more of the following circumstances are shown to exist:
