CHAPTER 187

AN ACT to amend 129.17 of the statutes, relating to peddling of printed matter by deaf persons.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

129.17 of the statutes is amended to read:

129.17 No person shall in this state engage in the business of peddling finger alphabet cards *or printed matter stating that the person is deaf*, or use finger alphabet cards *or such printed matter* in any way as a means of inducement in the sale of merchandise; and no state or local license as provided in this chapter shall be issued to any person for the purpose of peddling finger alphabet cards *or printed matter stating that the person is deaf*. Any person who shall peddle finger alphabet cards *or such printed matter* or use * * * *the same* in any way as a means of inducement in the sale of merchandise in this state and any person who shall issue any state or local license as provided in this chapter for that purpose shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by imprisonment in the county jail not more than 60 days or by a fine of not less than \$10 nor more than \$50.
