CHAPTER 2.

AN ACT to provide a cost of living bonus for legislative employes and making an appropriation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the general fund to the legislature for the 1953 regular session and, as to clerks detailed for service during such period under s. 13.14 (6) for 30 days thereafter, or any special session intervening between the 1953 and 1955 regular sessions, a sum sufficient to provide a cost of living bonus to each legislative employe, as follows: \$2 per calendar day to each employe paid from the appropriations made under s. 20.01 (2) (b), (2m) (b), (5) (a), (b), (c), (6) (a), (b), (c), (e), (7) (a), (b), (8) (a), (b) and (9) of the statutes. Such bonus shall be paid monthly and shall be computed from the effective date of this section. The proper certification officer shall monthly certify to the department of budget and accounts the amount due each such employe under this section and the director of budget and accounts shall draw his warrant for the amount so certified for each such employe.

SECTION 2. This bill is declared to be an emergency executive budget bill in accordance with the provisions of s. 15.11 (2).
