CHAPTER 229

AN ACT to amend 40.02 (5) as renumbered and amended by SECTION 23, chapter 90, laws of 1953 (Bill No. 1, S.) of the statutes, relating to joint county school committees.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

40.02 (5) as renumbered and amended by SECTION 23, chapter 90, laws of 1953 (Bill No. 1, S.) is amended to read:

40.02 (5) *JOINT COMMITTEE.* If territory to be affected by a county school committee order lies in 2 or more counties the county school committees of said counties shall act as a joint committee. The secretaries shall arrange the time and place of the first meeting. If the joint committee cannot agree, they shall appoint an additional member. The additional member shall be a resident of the state but not a resident of either county affected. *If the joint committee cannot agree upon an additional member within 30 days after their initial joint meeting, the secretaries shall immediately notify the circuit court judge within whose jurisdiction the largest portion of the counties involved lies, and he shall appoint an additional member within 15 days.*
