CHAPTER 235

AN ACT to amend 176.26 (2) of the statutes, relating to notice of persons to whom sale of intoxicants is forbidden.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

176.26 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

176.26 (2) And the wife of such person, the supervisors of any town, the aldermen of any city, the trustees of any village, the county superintendent of the poor of such county, the mayor of any city, the chairman of the county board of supervisors of such county * * * the district attorney or sheriff of such county, may, by a notice made and signed as aforesaid, in like manner forbid all persons in such town, city or village, to sell or give away intoxicating liquors or drinks or fermented malt beverages to any person given to the excessive use of such liquors, drinks or beverages, specifying such person, and such notice shall have the same force and effect when such specified person is a nonresident as is herein provided when such specified person is a resident of said town, city or village.
