**CHAPTER 25.**

AN ACT to amend 41.73 (4) of the statutes, relating to special training for pupils attending Wisconsin schools for the visually handicapped and the deaf.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

41.73 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:

41.73 (4) The state superintendent may arrange for vocational \* \* \*, trade or academic training for any pupil *in either of such state schools* qualified to take such training advantageously \* \* \*, in either the \* \* \* *public schools* or vocational school or a private business establishment in Janesville or Delavan. The \* \* \* *public schools* and the vocational school shall be paid the regular tuition for full-time attendance and pro rata for part-time attendance out of the appropriation in s. 20.21 (9a).
