CHAPTER 274

AN ACT to amend 86.16 (1) of the statutes, relating to the laying of water pipes in town highways.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

86.16 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

86.16 (1) Any person, firm or corporation including any corporation licensed under ch. 226 may, with the written consent of the town board, but subject to the approval of the state highway commission, construct and operate telegraph, telephone or electric lines, or pipes or pipe lines for the purpose of transmitting messages, *water*, heat, light or power along, across or within the limits of any highway.
