CHAPTER 35.

AN ACT authorizing the state department of public welfare to sell and convey a portion of the state-owned lands connected with the central state hospital and appropriating the proceeds therefrom for the purpose of paying the expenses of sale and for acquiring for the state other adjacent land, buildings and equipment.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

The director of the department of public welfare, with the approval of the governor, is authorized to sell and convey that portion of the state-owned lands connected with the central state hospital lying north of Lincoln street in the city of Waupun, under such terms, conditions and covenants as the director shall determine; and the proceeds of such sale or sales shall be deposited in the general fund of the state treasury and are appropriated therefrom to the department of public welfare for the purpose of paying the expenses of such sale or sales and for acquiring other lands adjacent to the central state hospital property, and for buildings and equipment.
