CHAPTER 387

AN ACT to appropriate to Ira Borton a sum therein named for financial losses resulting from the faulty testing of a dairy herd.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

There is appropriated from the general fund \$945.73 to Ira Borton, town of Henrietta, Richland county to compensate him for losses resulting from the faulty testing of his dairy herd by an inept employe of the state department of agriculture which resulted in the sale of 3 dairy cows erroneously classified as reactors to the test for Brucellosis and the retention of 3 dairy cows erroneously designated as clean when in reality they were reactors which resulted in the loss of milk, the loss of calves and the danger of further herd infection. Acceptance of this appropriation shall operate as a full and complete release to the state of any claim arising by virtue of such losses.
