**CHAPTER 406**

AN ACT to create 147.24 (8) of the statutes, relating to licensing of chiropractors.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

147.24 (8) of the statutes is created to read:

147.24 (8) The board may without further process revoke the license of one who fails to annually register and pay the fee within 60 days after written notice, mailed to his last known address by registered mail. His license may be reinstated, in the discretion of the board, by the payment of \$25 within one year from revocation. If application for reinstatement is not made within a period of one year from revocation he may be required to demonstrate that he is still qualified to practice by taking an examination in such chiropractic subjects as may be required by the board. The fee for such examination and reinstatement of license shall be \$50.
