CHAPTER 539

AN ACT to amend 252.073 and 256.325 of the statutes, relating to expenses of certain judges.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 252.073 of the statutes is amended to read:

252.073 A circuit judge shall be paid actual and necessary expenses incurred in the discharge of judicial duty outside his own county and in attending meetings of the board of circuit judges *and the board of criminal court judges.*

SECTION 2. 256.325 of the statutes is amended to read:

256.325 The full-time judges of the courts of record of the state, having criminal jurisdiction, constitute the board of criminal court judges. The board shall meet at least twice each year at such time and place as it determines. The board shall elect a chairman, secretary and such other officers from its number as it deems necessary. Such

officers shall perform such duties as the board prescribes. Each such judge *except a circuit judge*, attending the meetings of the board shall on presenting his certificate of attendance to the county or municipal treasurer be reimbursed for his travel and reasonable and necessary expenses out of the funds made available for his court.

SECTION 3. The effective date of this act shall be retroactive to July 1, 1951.
