CHAPTER 544

AN ACT to amend 126.06 and 126.74 of the statutes, relating to definition of public warehouses.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 126.06 of the statutes is amended to read:

126.06 All commercial grain warehouses in Superior, and all warehouses in said city in which the grain of different owners is so stored that the identity of different lots cannot be accurately preserved, and all warehouses in said city which issue warehouse receipts for grain are public warehouses. Any commercial warehouse in any other city * * * in this state which is operated in a manner described in this section and which issues warehouse receipts for grain may, upon request, be declared by the commission to be a public warehouse and shall thereafter be subject to the provisions of this chapter.

SECTION 2. 126.74 of the statutes is amended to read:

126.74 This chapter does not apply to cities of the first class, *except with respect to such commercial warehouses therein as may, upon request, have been declared by the commission to be public warehouses pursuant to the provisions of s. 126.06.*
