CHAPTER 561

AN ACT to create 13.351 (2) (d) of the statutes, relating to the long-range public building program.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

13.351 (2) (d) of the statutes is created to read:

13.351 (2) (d) 1. The state building commission shall report to the legislature at each regular session, for purposes of legislative review, the progress made from all appropriations including federal aid provided since the adjourned 1943 legislative session to carry out the state's public building program. Such report shall be part of the budget document and shall include for each state agency projects completed, under construction and contemplated from unencumbered and unallocated appropriations and for each project estimated and final costs and such other data as the commission shall determine. The governor shall include in his biennial budget message such additional amounts for projects in the state's public building program as he and the state building commission recommend should be appropriated by the legislature for the succeeding biennium.

2. It is the intent of the legislature that it be given a complete picture of the results of its past decisions regarding the state's building program which will serve as background for making further decisions.
