CHAPTER 578

AN ACT to create 370.01 (50), (51) and (52) of the statutes, relating to construction of statutes; words and phrases.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

370.01 (50), (51) and (52) of the statutes are created to read:

370.01 (50) CONTROLLED ACCESS HIGHWAY. "Controlled access highway" means a highway on which abutting property owners have no right or only a limited right of direct access and on which the type and location of all access connections are determined and controlled by the highway authorities.

(51) EXPRESS HIGHWAY OR EXPRESSWAY. "Express highway or expressway" means a highway with full or partial control of access and with the important crossroads separated in grade from the pavements for through traffic.

(52) FREEWAY. "Freeway" means a highway with full control of access and with all crossroads separated in grade from the pavements for through traffic.
