#### CHAPTER 634

AN ACT to amend 66.907 (2) (f) of the statutes, as repealed and recreated by chapter 246, laws of 1953, relating to earnings or payment for personal services received by a disability annuitant under the Wisconsin retirement fund.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

66.907 (2) (f) of the statutes, as repealed and recreated by chapter 246, laws of 1953, is amended to read:

66.907 (2) (f) Notwithstanding the fact that a disability annuity is granted for life, if any disability annuitant shall receive \* \* \* *or shall have received payment* for personal services in any calendar year in excess of \$1,000 such annuity shall be suspended by the board. Such annuity may be reinstated by the board as of the beginning of the month following board action, upon a showing by the annuitant that such personal services have terminated. The board may require certifications as to \* \* \* *such payments* for personal services prior to the subsequent issuance of annuity checks.
