

CHAPTER 658

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money therein named to Ervin Jakubiak, Ignatz Jakubiak and Raymond Jakubiak for losses sustained as a result of condemnation of swine due to vesicular exanthema.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

There is appropriated from the general fund to the state department of agriculture the sum of \$7,221.73 for payment to the following persons, who reside in the town of Lake, Milwaukee County, in the amounts stipulated, as indemnity for loss of swine which died or were condemned to slaughter because of the disease known as vesicular exanthema, such payment to be made pursuant to a co-operative disease control agreement with the federal bureau of animal industry as provided in s. 95.17 of the statutes:

Ignatz Jakubiak, 5220 South 13th St., Milwaukee, Wisconsin, 164 head of swine	\$2,306.40
Raymond Jakubiak, 5260 South 13th St., Milwaukee, Wisconsin, 185 head of swine.....	\$2,246.48

Acceptance of this appropriation shall operate as a complete release to the state of any claims by Ervin Jakubiak, Ignatz Jakubiak and Raymond Jakubiak as a result of the death or slaughter of these swine.
