CHAPTER 88.

AN ACT authorizing and directing the adjutant general on behalf of the state of Wisconsin to transfer and convey to the city of Hudson the real estate therein described and which was conveyed to the state of Wisconsin by the city of Hudson in 1922 for armory purposes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

The adjutant general on behalf of the state of Wisconsin is authorized to convey to the city of Hudson the real estate conveyed by the city of Hudson to the state of Wisconsin in 1922 for armory purposes, said real estate being situated in the city of Hudson, county of St. Croix and described as follows:

Lot 8, block 11, of Buena Vista, now a part of city of Hudson, except 8 feet off east end for an alley; also following parcel of land, to-wit: All that part of lot 7 in block 11, Buena Vista, now a part of city of Hudson, which lies north of a line extended east and west through north line of that part of lot 7 in said block 11, of Buena Vista aforesaid heretofore conveyed to James Johnson and Eric Christenson by warranty deed dated October 9, 1891 and recorded in book "49" on page 475.

No such conveyance shall be consummated unless first approved by the governor.
