**CHAPTER 119**

AN ACT to amend 29.47 (2) (c) and (3) (a) of the statutes, relating to the transportation of fish.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

29.47 (2) (c) and (3) (a) of the statutes are amended to read:

29.47 (2) (c) All fish *which are subject to a minimum size limit and are* transported as provided in this section shall be entirely intact and with no part removed except the scales, gills and viscera.

(3) (a) No green fish of any variety *except lawfully taken suckers* shall be shipped from any port located on outlying waters during the closed season for such fish, except the first 3 days thereof.
