CHAPTER 149

AN ACT to create 60.29 (41) and 60.74 (8) of the statutes, relating to the establishment of regional planning programs.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 60.29 (41) of the statutes is created to read:

60.29 (41) ENTER REGIONAL PLANNING PROGRAMS. To act jointly with other municipalities in the area to establish and maintain a regional planning program to protect the health, safety and general welfare of the town as part of the region, and to make payments out of the general fund for the pro rata share of the cost of such program.

SECTION 2. 60.74 (8) of the statutes is created to read:

60.74 (8) Town boards acting under s. 60.29 (41) to participate in a regional planning program may adopt town zoning ordinances in the

manner provided in s. 61.35 notwithstanding any provision of this section or s. 60.75 provided that:

- (a) Such adopted ordinance conforms to the regional plan.
- (b) Such ordinance is approved by the county board in counties having a county ordinance.
- (c) The electors of the town have had an opportunity to approve or disapprove such ordinance at a regular annual meeting and have not disapproved it.
