CHAPTER 198

AN ACT to create 152.085 of the statutes, relating to an injunctional remedy for enforcing chapter 152.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

152.085 of the statutes is created to read:

152.085 INJUNCTION TO ENFORCE CHAPTER 152. If it appears upon the complaint of any person to the board of dental examiners,

or it is believed by the board that any person is violating any of the provisions of this chapter, the board or the district attorney of the proper county may investigate such alleged violation, and may, in addition to or in lieu of any other remedies provided by law, bring action in the name and on behalf of the state against any such person to enjoin such violation. Between meetings of the board, its president and secretary, acting in its behalf, are empowered jointly to make such an investigation, and on the basis thereof to bring such an action.
