**CHAPTER 264**

AN ACT to amend chapter 201, laws of 1937, section 5 (1) (c) as created by chapter 357, laws of 1947, section 9, relating to general employes' and sheriffs' retirement system in counties having a population of 500,000 or more.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

Chapter 201, laws of 1937, section 5 (1) (c), as created by chapter 357, laws of 1947, section 9, is amended to read:

(Chapter 201, laws 1937) Section 5 (1) (c). Each member in active service, except deputy sheriffs, who has attained the age of 70, and in the case of deputy sheriffs the age of 63, on the date of the establishment of the retirement system or who thereafter attains such age, shall be retired at the end of the month at which such age is attained. A member who is

elected by vote of the people shall not be required to retire at age 70.  
\* \* \* *This amendment (1955) shall not affect continuances in service  
after age 70, effective prior to the effective date (1955) of this amendment.*
