CHAPTER 425

AN ACT to amend 101.01 (1) of the statutes, relating to the definition of place of employment.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

101.01 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

101.01 (1) The phrase "place of employment" * * * means and * * * includes every place, whether indoors or out or underground and the premises appurtenant thereto where either temporarily or permanently any industry, trade or business is carried on, or where any process or operation, directly or indirectly related to any industry, trade or business, is carried on, and where any person is, directly or indirectly, employed by another for direct or indirect gain or profit, but shall not include any place where persons are employed in (a) private domestic service which does not involve the use of mechanical power or (b) * * * farming. The term "farming" includes those activities specified in s. 102.04 (4), and also includes the transportation of farm products, supplies or equipment directly to the farm by the operator of said farm or his employes for use thereon, if such activities are directly or indirectly for the purpose of producing commodities for market, or as an accessory to such production.
