CHAPTER 549

AN ACT to create 85.08 (25c) (am), (26) (am) and (29) (am) of the statutes, relating to fees for drivers licenses after revocation or suspension.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

85.08 (25c) (am), (26) (am) and (29) (am) of the statutes are created to read:

85.08 (25c) (am) No person 18 years of age or over shall file a petition for an occupational license unless he first pays to the county treasurer a fee of \$10. The treasurer shall give such person a receipt and shall pay the full amount of the fee to the state treasurer, to be deposited in the general fund.

(26) (am) The payment of a fee of \$10, but this paragraph shall not apply to persons under the age of 18;

(29) (am) The payment of a fee of \$10, but this paragraph shall not apply to persons under the age of 18;
