CHAPTER 568

AN ACT to create 40.70 (5) (d) of the statutes, relating to aids to union high school districts.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

40.70 (5) (d) of the statutes is created to read:

40.70 (5) (d) When a new union high school district is created comprised of territory in which a high school is not in operation, such district may, in its first year of operation, operate classes for ninth and tenth grades and provide for its eleventh and twelfth grade pupils on a tuition basis, and in its second year of operation, operate classes for the ninth, tenth and eleventh grade and provide for its twelfth grade pupils on a tuition basis, and qualify for receipt of aids on account of such 2 first years of operation at the same rate of aids per pupil in average daily attendance as it would have been eligible to receive if it had operated the ninth, tenth, eleventh and twelfth grades.
