CHAPTER 671

AN ACT to create 20.005 (1) (b) (line 359s) of the statutes, to appropriate \$3,338.61 to Louis H. Larson to compensate him for overpayments made in error to the state of Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 20.005 (1) (b) (line 359s) of the statutes is created to read:

20.005 (1) (b)	
359s. Louis H. Larson	\$3,338.61

SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the general fund to Louis H. Larson, 6326 46th Avenue, Kenosha, Wisconsin, the sum of \$3,338.61 to compensate him for overpayments made in error to the state public welfare department from 1941 to 1952, which payments were not required by law, but were made due to a mutual mistake as to the obligations of a parent to pay for institutional care of a son over 21 years of age. Acceptance of this appropriation shall operate as a full and complete release to the state of any claim arising by virtue of such losses.
