

CHAPTER 88

AN ACT to amend 66.054 (5) (e) and 176.05 (7) of the statutes, relating to exempting aircraft from liquor and fermented malt beverage license law.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. 66.054 (5) (e) of the statutes is amended to read:

66.054 (5) (e) No license shall be imposed upon the sale of fermented malt beverages upon any railroad sleeping, buffet *or cafe* car or steamboat *or aircraft* while in transit or in any public park operated by any county, city, town or village when sold by officers or employes thereof pursuant to any ordinance, resolution, rule or regulation enacted by the governing body of such municipality where the receipts from such sales go into the public treasuries.

SECTION 2. 176.05 (7) of the statutes is amended to read:

176.05 (7) NO LICENSE ON RAILROADS OR AIRCRAFT. No license shall be required for the sale of intoxicating liquor upon any dining, buffet, *or cafe* car operated upon any railroad, *or upon any aircraft*, but such liquor shall be sold and furnished only to bona fide passengers or other persons actually being transported, and shall be consumed only in such dining, buffet, *or cafe* car *or aircraft* while in transit.
