CHAPTER 141

AN ACT to create 15.18 (2a) of the statutes, relating to the approval of out of state travel.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

15.18 (2a) of the statutes is created to read:

15.18 (2a) APPROVAL OF OUT OF STATE TRAVEL. The governor may delegate the authority to approve items of expenditures for travel while attending meetings outside the state to his staff or to the department of budget and accounts. He may also determine whether such requests shall be made on an individual basis or by means of periodic reports from the several departments of the state. The governor may also require periodic reports on out of state travel made by the personnel of each state agency with such detail as he may desire.
