

CHAPTER 147

AN ACT to amend 1.10 of the statutes, relating to the designation of the white-tailed deer as the state animal.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

1.10 of the statutes is amended to read:

1.10 The Wisconsin state tree is the sugar maple (*acer saccharum*); the Wisconsin state flower is the wood violet (*viola papilionacea*); the Wisconsin state bird is the robin (*turdus migratorius*); the Wisconsin state fish is the muskellunge (*Esox masquinongy masquinongy* Mitchell); *the Wisconsin state animal is the badger (*taxidea taxus*) and the Wisconsin wild life animal is the white-tailed deer (*odocoileus virginianus*). The Wisconsin Blue Book shall include the information contained in this section concerning the state tree, flower, bird, fish, animal and wild life animal.*
