**CHAPTER 218**

AN ACT to create 49.12 (8) of the statutes, relating to the burden of proof in public assistance fraud prosecutions.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

49.12 (8) of the statutes is created to read:

49.12 (8) Any person who makes any statement under oath to the authorities charged with the responsibility of furnishing assistance shall be considered to have made an admission as to the existence, correctness or validity of any fact stated, which shall be taken as prima facie evidence against the party making it in any complaint, information or indictment, and in any action or proceeding brought for the enforcement of any provision of this chapter.
