CHAPTER 267

AN ACT to create 66.054 (22) of the statutes, relating to furnishing fermented malt beverages to, and possession thereof by, nonresident persons under 21 years of age.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

66.054 (22) of the statutes is created to read:

66.054 (22) FURNISHING TO NONRESIDENT PERSONS UNDER 21. No person shall sell, dispense, give away or furnish any fermented malt beverages to any person under the age of 21 years who is not a resident of this state and is a resident of any state bordering on Wisconsin which prohibits the sale of fermented malt beverages to any person under the age of 21 years, and no such person shall possess any fermented malt beverages, unless he is accompanied by parent or guardian or spouse. For the purposes of this subsection, students may be deemed residents of the municipality in which they reside while attending school and members of the armed services may be deemed residents of the municipality in which they are stationed at the time.
