CHAPTER 272

AN ACT to amend 269.34 (4) of the statutes, relating to service of papers by mail.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

269.34 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:

269.34 (4) Service may be made by mailing such copy where the person making the service and the person on whom it is made reside in different places between which there is a communication by mail. The copy of the paper to be served must be properly enclosed in a postpaid wrapper (which may bear the sender's name and address) and must be addressed to the person on whom it is to be served at his proper post-office address, but, *except as to proceedings in county court*, without any request to the postal officers upon the wrapper for the return thereof in case of non-delivery to the person addressed.
