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CHAPTER 279

AN ACT to amend 97.02 (5) (a) and (r) of the statutes, relating to butter fat content in milk and chocolate milk.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

97.02 (5) (a) and (r) of the statutes are amended to read:

97.02 (5) (a) Milk is the whole, fresh, clean, lacteal secretion obtained by the complete milking of one or more healthy cows, excluding that obtained within 15 days before and 5 days after calving, or such longer period as may be necessary to render the milk colostrum-free. Milk shall contain not less than 3 per cent of milk fat, and not less than 8.25 per cent of milk solids not fat. Milk may be standardized by the addition or removal of cream or by the addition of skim milk. When so standardized milk shall contain not less than * * * 3.3 per cent of milk fat, and not less than 8.25 per cent of milk solids not fat.

(r) Chocolate milk or chocolate flavored milk is milk sweetened and flavored with chocolate or cocoa. It may contain added salt, milk solids not fat and stabilizers approved by the department, and contains not less than * * * 3.3 per cent milk fat.
