**CHAPTER 29**

AN ACT to amend chapter 52, laws of 1955, section 2, relating to the conveyance of certain submerged lands to the city of Oshkosh.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

Chapter 52, laws of 1955, section 2, is amended to read:  
(Chapter 52, laws of 1955) Section 2. The breakwater shall have such openings and bridges as may be prescribed by the public service

commission and plans for the structure shall be approved by said commission. The following shall be the dimensions of the pier and breakwater: The width of the top of the surface shall be 45 feet and the center line of the top surface shall begin at a point on the shore of Lake Winnebago 22-1/2 feet southerly from the north line of Fourteenth street, thence easterly and parallel to said north line extended \* \* \* 300 feet, thence \* \* \* northeasterly (N. 18°-O'E) 350 feet, the whole to be \* \* \* constructed as to form a harbor for boats.
