

CHAPTER 294

AN ACT to renumber and amend 346.16 as created by chapter 260, laws of 1957 (Bill No. 99, S.); and to create 346.16 (2) and 349.105 of the statutes, relating to regulation of the use of expressways and freeways, and providing a penalty.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 346.16 of the statutes, as created by chapter 260, laws of 1957 (Bill No. 99, S.), is renumbered 346.16 (1) and amended to read:

346.16 USE OF CONTROLLED-ACCESS HIGHWAYS, EXPRESSWAYS AND FREEWAYS. (1) No person shall drive a vehicle onto or from a controlled-access highway * * *, expressway or freeway except through an opening provided for that purpose.

SECTION 2. 346.16 (2) of the statutes is created to read:

346.16 (2) No pedestrian or person riding a bicycle or other non-motorized vehicle or person operating a power driven cycle or motor bicycle shall go upon any expressway or freeway when official signs have been erected prohibiting such person from using the expressway or freeway.

SECTION 3. 349.105 of the statutes is created to read:

349.105 AUTHORITY TO PROHIBIT CERTAIN TRAFFIC ON EXPRESSWAYS AND FREEWAYS. The authority in charge of maintenance of an expressway or freeway may, by order, ordinance or resolution, prohibit the use of such expressway or freeway by pedestrians, persons riding bicycles or other nonmotorized traffic or by persons operating power driven cycles or motor bicycles. The state or local authority adopting any such prohibitory regulation shall erect and maintain official signs giving notice thereof on the expressway or freeway to which such prohibition applies.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 1958.
