CHAPTER 306

AN ACT to amend 220.29 of the statutes, to permit banks to be open for the transaction of business on February 22 and November 11.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

220.29 of the statutes is amended to read:

220.29 (1) No state bank, trust company bank or mutual savings bank shall transact business or be open for the purpose of transacting business on Sunday or any legal holiday under s. 256.17 designated by the commissioner of banks except that they may transact business or be open for the purpose of transacting business on any election day, city, county, state or national, or on February 12 * * *, *February 22*, October 12 *and November 11* in each year or on the succeeding Monday whenever any such day shall fall on a Sunday.

(2) Nothing in any law of this state shall in any manner whatsoever affect the validity of, or render void or voidable, the payment, certification or acceptance of a check or other negotiable instrument or any transaction by a bank because done or performed on any election day, city, county, state or national, or on February 12 * * *, *February 22*, October 12 *and November 11* in each year or on the succeeding Monday whenever any such day shall fall on a Sunday; nothing herein shall be construed to compel any bank to keep open for the transaction of business on any legal holiday.
