CHAPTER 320

- AN ACT to amend 40.02 (1) of the statutes, relating to county school committees.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
 - 40.02 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 40.02 (1) (a) In each county, there shall be a county school committee of 6 county residents. The county board shall appoint 2 members for 3-year terms at its annual November meeting. Three members shall be residents of cities or villages and 3 shall be residents of towns, except that

in counties having a population of 500,000 or more, * * * 6 members shall be appointed at large, but no more than one member shall be a resident

of any one town, village or city.

(b) If there be one city within the county, at least one of the city-village members shall be a resident of that city. If there are 2 or more cities, at least 2 of the city-village members shall be residents of cities. If there is no city or village in the county, all members shall be residents of towns, but not more than one member shall be from any one town. * * * Two members of the committee may be * * * members of the county board. Each term commences January 1 after appointment. All members shall serve until their successors have qualified. The county superintendent shall serve as secretary to the committee but shall not be entitled to your serve as secretary to the committee but shall not be entitled to vote.
