CHAPTER 367

AN ACT to renumber 139.50 (23) (intro. par.); to amend 139.50 (4) (b); and to create 139.50 (23) (am) of the statutes, relating to wholesale tobacco distributors.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 139.50 (4) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

139.50 (4) (b) If any manufacturer or wholesaler violates * * * this section *or s. 100.30* the commissioner of taxation may suspend or revoke such permit for such period of time as he may determine.

SECTION 2. 139.50 (23) (intro. par.) of the statutes is renumbered 139.50 (23) (a).

SECTION 3. 139.50 (23) (am) of the statutes is created to read:

139.50 (23) (am) No representative of any manufacturer who deals in the tobacco products of such manufacturer and who is so registered as a salesman, shall sell more than 3 cartons of any one kind of cigarettes at any time to any one retailer.
