CHAPTER 40

AN ACT relating to conveyance by the state to the city of Kenosha of certain creek lands and authorizing said city to fill in a portion of Pike Creek.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. All right, title and interest of the state in and to land submerged beneath the waters of that portion of Pike Creek which lies above the easterly side of the highway bridge at Sixth Avenue in the city of Kenosha, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, which was declared to be a nonnavigable stream by Act of Congress (P. L. 169, 84th Congress, 1st Session), is hereby granted to the city of Kenosha.

SECTION 2. The city of Kenosha is authorized to fill in that portion of Pike Creek conveyed in SECTION 1, in order to prevent the formation of stagnant water and offensive odors, and use said lands for parks, schools, recreation areas or other purposes deemed by the common council to be in the best interests of the city.
