CHAPTER 418

AN ACT to repeal and recreate 108.05 (1) (schedule) (line 28); and to create 108.05 (1) (schedule) (lines 29 to 30) of the statutes, relating to increasing maximum wage class for unemployment compensation benefits.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 108.05 (1) (schedule) (line 28) of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:

| 28. | \$70.01 to 72.00 ----- | \$36 |

SECTION 2. 108.05 (1) (schedule) (lines 29 to 30) of the statutes are created to read:

| Line | Average Weekly Wage Class | Weekly Benefit Rate |
| 29. | \$72.01 to 74.00 ----- | \$37 |
| 30. | 74.01 or more ----- | 38 |

SECTION 3. The changes effected by this act in section 108.05 (1) of the statutes shall apply only to those benefit determinations, issued under chapter 108 of the statutes, whose first benefit check is issued after that calendar month which follows the month in which this act is officially published.
