CHAPTER 428

AN ACT to amend 40.27 (9) of the statutes, relating to the election of school board members at the spring election.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

40.27 (9) of the statutes is amended to read:

40.27 (9) Any school district maintaining a school offering instruction in grades one through 12 and containing within its boundaries a city of the second, third, or fourth class, or village, or any union high school district, may adopt the method provided in sub. (8) for the election of its school board, but such election shall be held on the first Tuesday in April. At such elections the electors of the district shall vote at the polling place where they normally vote for state, local and judicial officers, and the election officials for state and local elections shall serve.
