CHAPTER 446

AN ACT to amend chapter 124, laws of 1871, sections 1 and 4, as amended by chapter 468, laws of 1917, relating to trustees of the Milwaukee county orphans' board.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Chapter 124, laws of 1871, sections 1 and 4, as amended by chapter 468, laws of 1917, are amended to read:

(Chapter 124, laws of 1871) Section 1. The judges of the circuit court of the second judicial circuit, of the municipal court of the city and county of Milwaukee, of the county court of Milwaukee county, of the civil court of Milwaukee county, * * * of the district court of Milwaukee county, *and of the children's court of Milwaukee county*, and the successors of such judges in the manner hereinafter described, shall be and are hereby declared a body politic and corporate by the name of "the Trustees of the Milwaukee County Orphans' Board," and by that name may contract and be contracted with, sue and be sued, defend and be defended against in any and all courts.

Section 4. The money received by the said corporation shall be invested in bonds or other securities of the kind or character described in section * * * 320.01 of the statutes * * *. No investment shall be made except upon the written direction or approval of a majority of such trustees.
