CHAPTER 47

AN ACT to amend 59.03 (2) (e) of the statutes, relating to substitutes for supervisor in cities and villages in counties of less than 500,000 population.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

59.03 (2) (e) of the statutes is amended to read:

59.03 (2) (e) If any town chairman is unable to attend any meeting of the county board, either of the other members of the town board, to be designated by themselves (and if they disagree they shall decide by lot), shall attend the meeting as a member of the county board, but he shall not so act until the town clerk certifies to the county clerk that he was so designated. In cities and villages a substitute for any supervisor may be appointed in such case by the mayor or village president, and the city or village clerk shall certify the designation to the county clerk; *or the mayor or village president may attend the meeting and act as a member of the county board with certification.*
