

CHAPTER 510

AN ACT to create chapter 512, laws of 1955, section 1, 4, relating to conferring justice court jurisdiction on the Burnett county court and its judge.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Chapter 512, laws of 1955, section 1, 4, is created to read:

(Chapter 512, laws of 1955) Section 1. 4. The county court and its judge shall have concurrent jurisdiction with justices of the peace in civil and criminal actions and proceedings, and justice court practice, procedure, fees, costs and other charges, and requirements governing the disposition of fines, forfeitures and other moneys, as is provided by statute, shall apply also to all actions and proceedings wherein said county court is exercising justice court jurisdiction.
