CHAPTER 520

AN ACT to amend 20.280 (91) of the statutes, relating to the allocation of revenue from the sale of sportsmen's licenses.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 20.280 (91) of the statutes is amended to read:

20.280 (91) All moneys collected by the conservation commission or its authorized agents for voluntary sportsmen's licenses pursuant to s. 29.147 shall be paid within 10 days after receipt to the state treasurer who shall deposit all fees so collected for sportsmen's licenses into the conservation fund, and all moneys collected for any such license over and above the sum of * * * \$7.50 shall constitute an account to be known as the "Public Hunting and Fishing Fund"; and all moneys deposited in such "Public Hunting and Fishing Fund" are appropriated to the conservation commission for the purpose of acquiring lands for game refuges and public fishing and hunting grounds. Any unexpended balance in such account at the close of any fiscal year is reappropriated to said "Public Hunting and Fishing Fund" for said purposes. Of this appropriation there is allotted on July 1, 1955, \$170,633, and annually, beginning July 1, 1956, \$182,233 to carry out the provisions of this subsection.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 1958.
