CHAPTER 558

AN ACT to amend 235.46 of the statutes, relating to recorded affidavits as evidence of corporate authority to convey.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

235.46 of the statutes is amended to read:

235.46 Affidavits, witnessed by 2 subscribing witnesses, stating facts as to possession of any premises, descent, heirship, date of birth, death or marriage, or \* \* \* the identity of a party to any conveyance of record, or that any such party was or is single or married, or as to the identification of any plats or subdivisions of any city or village, *or as to corporate authorization to convey*, may be recorded in the office of the register of deeds in any county where such conveyance is recorded, or within which such premises or city or village is situated, and the record of any such affidavit, or a certified copy thereof, shall be prima facie evidence of the facts touching any such matter, which are therein stated.
