

CHAPTER 631

AN ACT to amend chapter 250, laws of 1953, sections 7 and 8, as created by chapter 106, laws of 1957, relating to extending the life of the interstate bridge commission, and providing for payment of expenses.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 250, laws of 1953, section 7, is amended to read:

(Chapter 250, laws of 1953) Section 7. The members of the commission shall be reimbursed for all expenses actually and necessarily incurred in the performance of their duties. Commission as used in this act shall mean committee within the meaning of s. * * * 20.530 (1) (c). *At the close of each fiscal year beginning with July 1, 1953, the general fund shall be reimbursed by the state highway fund for the expenses paid on behalf of the interstate bridge commission upon certification by the director of budget and accounts of such amounts to the state highway commission.*

SECTION 2. Chapter 250, laws of 1953, section 8, as created by chapter 106, laws of 1957, is amended to read:

(Chapter 250, laws of 1953) Section 8. The existence of the commission is extended to the date of the adjournment sine die of the regular 1959 session of the legislature. *Notwithstanding any other provision the commission shall consist of 2 senators and 3 assemblymen to be appointed as are members of standing committees and 2 public members with knowledge of the plans for the interstate bridge to be appointed by the governor.*
