

CHAPTER 643

AN ACT to amend 40.70 (1) of the statutes, relating to state aids for kindergarten pupils.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

40.70 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

40.70 (1) "Pupils in average daily attendance" is the sum of actual daily attendances in all schools of the district for each day of the school term divided by the number of days school is actually held. The quotient, if it contains a fraction, shall be expressed as the nearest whole number. In computing the number of pupils in average daily attendance no first grade pupil shall be counted unless he attains the age of 6 years on or before December 1 of the school year in which he enters first grade. A pupil enrolled in a recognized half-day kindergarten program shall be counted as one-half pupil provided he attains the age of 5 years on or before December 1 of the year in which he enrolls. A pupil enrolled in a 4-year-old * * * kindergarten program shall *not* be counted * * *. The same formula shall be used in computing average daily attendance for resident pupils, nonresident pupils, or both.
